



STATEMENT REGARDING RE-ELECTION AS 2ND DISTRICT SUPERVISOR

Santa Ana, Calif. (July 9, 2026) – On June 26, Orange County Registrar of Voters Bob Page officially certified the results of the June 2, 2026, Statewide Direct Primary Election.

After all the votes were received and counted, I was humbled to learn that I had been selected to serve another four years as your Second District Supervisor. I wanted to share some thoughts regarding the election and the work of our office.
